Instruments provided: 1 – 5 Piece Drum Kit 1 – Digital Piano 1 – Keyboard 6 – Mics

- The music performed should not make use of any vulgar language, inappropriate slurs, or racially offensive terminology.
- Any explicit version of music played will result in severe consequences.
- No background track can be used.

• Original tracks can be played.

*Any additional instruments that may be required should be brought in by participants themselves.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity
- Connection to the theme
- Time management
- Composition
- Description of the art, maximum 400 words (must be submitted with the artwork on a piece of paper)

- The school will not provide brushes, paints and palettes participants are expected to get their own.
- Participants from Category 1 and Category 2 can only use acrylic paints to create their final piece. Whereas participants from Category 3 can use paints of their choice.
- A canvas size of 18x24 inches for Category 1 (Gr 10 12), one A2 sheet per participant will be provided for Category 2 (Gr 6– 9), and one A3 sheet per participant will be provided for Category 3 (Gr 3–5).
- Any help received from other participants, staff, or teachers will result in disqualification.
- Candor International School will keep participants' work, and in the case that it is displayed on Candor's

social media or school platforms, the artist will receive credit.

- Participants will receive 30 minutes to make reference sketches of their choice, as no devices or printouts will be allowed during the event.
- Participants have a total of 3 hours to paint on the canvas.
- When given a break, it should be strictly adhered to.
- No plagiarism or AI should be used.

- A team of minimum of 8 to a maximum of 12 participants is compulsory per school
- Each team has 4 to 8 minutes to present their work
- Students from grade 6 to 12 are allowed to participate
- Only one team per school

CRITERIA:

- Creativity and uniqueness
- Fashion and styling
- Confidence
- Connection to the theme
- Work description

• Any suggestive performance or clothing that may be considered offensive will result in disqualification.

• At least one tagline should be presented either through music or any visual presentation that related to the topic.

• The timer will begin as soon as the team's name is

announced. Hence any delays from the team will result in a loss of performance time.
