## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All participants must arrive at the venue by 7:30 a.m. for registrations.
- All participants must carry their school and recent government ID cards. No participant will be allowed in the venue without both ID cards.
- Students may participate in both sports and cultural events.
- No participant will be allowed to leave the venue until all the respective day's events are complete.
- Food should not be brought to the event by participants. Bag checks will take place before any participant enters the premises.
- Attendees are encouraged to bring money to purchase items from food trucks and game stalls that will be available on campus during the event.
- During the event, the school is not responsible for any loss or damage to the participant's personal property.
- Any participants causing damage to school property will be noted by the organizing committee and subject to a fine.
- All forms of drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited at Aletheia. Any participant found to be in violation of this rule will be permanently banned, and their school blacklisted from future events.
- All participants must be accompanied by a teacher representative.

## SPORTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- In all cases, the referee's decision will be final and no arguments will be entertained. Captains may represent their teams in the event of any queries or issues.
- All sports will be conducted in the knockout format
- No Players/Managers/Coaches of the team shall be allowed to cross the technical line/playing area.
- Participants will be prohibited from wearing any accessories during the match.
- The participants will have to follow the reporting and match timings strictly, failure to adhere to the match timings will result in a walkover after 15 minutes.
- Teams should approach the official for any doubts regarding their sport. The referee and tournament managers shall have the power to make a decision on any point not specifically covered in the rules.
- Fixtures are subject to alteration by the organizing committee.
- Each school will be allowed to send only one team per category.
- Participants will only be allowed to take part in one age category.
- Any protest if at all launched must be done through the accredited sports in charge/coach of the team within half an hour of the conclusion of the event along with a protest fee of Rs. 1500/–. The protest must be handed over to the organizing secretary.

# FOOTBALL (DAY1AND 2)

Under 19 (Boys & Girls)

Under 15 (Boys & Girls)

Under 11 (Boys and Girls)

- The tournament will be played on the basis of knockouts.
- Match duration will be 10–5–10 (5 being half–time break)
- Semi-Finals and Finals will be for 15–10–15.
- If the score remains tied at the end of the match, each team will have 5 kicks. If the game remains tied it will enter a sudden death until a winner is decided.
- Each school is allowed to enter only one team in one category.
- Kick-ins should be along the ground; an aerial ball will result in a retake
- During a kick-in, the nearest opponent should be at least 7 yards from the ball or kick line.

- FIFA laws of the game apply with the following changes.
- 1. Substitution- Unlimited rolling substitute.
- 2. Offside- No offside rule applies.
- 3. Throw-in- will be a kick-in from the throw line.
- 4. Direct kick– from the throw line into the goal is not allowed (has to be indirect).

- Teams should be prepared to play more than one match per day.

- Teams should consist of 6+6 players.
- The tournament will be played based on knockouts.
- 15 points, best of 3 sets until the semi-finals.
- The semi-final and Finals will be for 25 points, best of 3 sets.
- During the 3rd set, a side change will happen after 8 points, and during the semi-finals & finals, it will occur after 11 points.
- The match will be conducted according to the FIVB regulations.
- In the case of a tie, the team leading by two points will be considered the winner. If the game is tied again, it will enter sudden death (golden point) until a winner is decided.
