## Comprehensive Policy Guidelines

### ANTI-BULLYING STATEMENT

Dear Parent,

The Supreme Court of India, UGC and Government of Karnataka have recommended very stringent measures to prevent Ragging in Educational Institutions.

According to these recommendations, any student found to be guilty of involvement in any act of Ragging will be summarily dismissed from the Institution with a remark in his Transfer Certificate to that Effect. Wherever necessary, the matter may also be referred to the Police.

Ragging includes tormenting others by words or deed, playing rough jokes on other, engaging in rough play, physical assault or threat, use of physical force, insubordination, verbal abuse and aggression, exhibiting indecent gestures and obscene behavior, exposing fellow students and others to ridicule and contempt, violating the status, dignity, and honor of fellow students and others, violating the privacy and rights of others, and hassling or exhibiting riotous behavior.

**In the light of the above, as per the recommendations of the Supreme Court, an annual joint declaration by the parent and the student is mandatory for the student to be enrolled for the classes.**
